

TOURS ESCAPE FROM HOI AN

1. OVERVIEW:

Hoi An (also Fai-Fo) is perhaps Vietnam's most atmospheric and delightful town. The town is an exceptionally well-preserved example of a Southeast Asian trading port dating from the 15th to the 19th century. Its architectures and street plan reflect the cultural mixing of Vietnam with the outside world, all combined to produce this unique heritage site.

The present-day Hoi An still remains much as its heyday without the presence of traffic or pollution. Whether you visit the town as a day or as long as a month, it's be worthwhile. Lounge bars, boutique hotels, café and tailor shops are very much part of the scene here. Travel a few kilometers further – you'll find some superb bicycle, motorbike and boat trips – and some of central Vietnam's most enticing, rural scenery and beaches are within easy reach.

Hoi An has no airport, no train station either. The only way to get here is by road from Da Nang which has an airport with daily flights from Hanoi, Ho Chi Minh City and other big cities. There's also a train station in Da Nang and bus services are all available.

Overview:

Experience a different way to visit the holy temples of the Champa kingdom which was built between the 4th to 13th century and the ancient town Hoi An. This unique biking tour takes you through the back roads and paths, cycling through the beautiful landscapes of Central Vietnam, and seeing the lives of local people along the way.

Itinerary:

Morning, meet our guide at your hotel in Hoi An Town (or Da Nang) and short transfer out of the town and ride to My Son world heritage. My Son is a great sample of the ancient Champa civilization which was an independent state from around the 2nd to the 17th century, at which time it was occupied by the South part of Vietnam. The impressive Hindu-themed ruins feature many beautiful stone sculptures, temples and towers in tropical jungle surroundings. Transfer back to Hoi An and then have lunch at a local restaurant.

Afternoon, continue to cycle and visit charming town with the Japanese Covered Bridge, Tam Ky House, Historical museum. End of day, cycling to the beach for swimming if you would like.
