

# TOURS ESCAPE FROM HOI AN

## **1. OVERVIEW:**

Hoi An (also Fai-Fo) is perhaps Vietnam's most atmospheric and delightful town. The town is an exceptionally well-preserved example of a Southeast Asian trading port dating from the 15<sup>th</sup> to the 19<sup>th</sup> century. Its architectures and street plan reflect the cultural mixing of Vietnam with the outside world, all combined to produce this unique heritage site.

The present-day Hoi An still remains much as its heyday without the presence of traffic or pollution. Whether you visit the town as a day or as long as a month, it's be worthwhile. Lounge bars, boutique hotels, café and tailor shops are very much part of the scene here. Travel a few kilometers further – you'll find some superb bicycle, motorbike and boat trips – and some of central Vietnam's most enticing, rural scenery and beaches are within easy reach.

Hoi An has no airport, no train station either. The only way to get here is by road from Da Nang which has an airport with daily flights from Hanoi, Ho Chi Minh City and other big cities. There's also a train station in Da Nang and bus services are all available.

Discover Hoi An with our half day walking tour. Stroll around the charming, old-world trading port of narrow streets and traditional houses, ancient merchants' homes, the town's iconic 400-year old Japanese Covered Bridge and the colorful market where an array of fresh dishes are on offer.

### **Itinerary:**

Meet our guide at your hotel in Hoi An (or Da Nang) and transfer out for a city tour in Hoi An. This city recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site is now popular as a city of peaceful with well-preserved architecture, lifestyles and traditions. Your visiting will be impressed by an enchanting fusion of culture from Vietnam and also outside world including China, Japan, Thailand and the Philippines. Today, to explore almost the main attracting spot in Hoi An, our guide will take you to the iconic 400 year old Covered Bridge which a Japanese-styled temple is based on. Then continue to the Museum of Trade Ceramics – a Vietnamese Style wooden house which has showcased antique ceramic artifacts since 1858, the Tan Ky House which has had a long lasting of 200 year old – an ancient Chinese merchant residence, the Ong temple for worshipping an ancient Chinese general who had been admired as his loyalty, bravery and justice - Guan Yu, which is built in 1653 by the Chinese settlers.
