

FULL DAY HUE BIKING TOUR

Time: Full day (08.30 – 16.30h.)

Overview:

More incredible way to discover many other charming of Hue ancient capital is to make a cycling trip around the city. Spending full day on bike by yourself, you will embark to the rural to admire and enjoy interesting scenes and local life. This tour gives you more the tranquil, peaceful, beautiful sightseeing in different villages surrounding Hue including green paddy fields, rivers, hill, handicraft villages, and old architecture, which Hue people keep in original appearance until now.

Itinerary:

Morning, pick you up at your hotel in Hue. Take city tour to visit Royal Citadel - Hue Citadel - Vietnam's former imperial capital and recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage site, then transfer to visit Thien Mu Pagoda and visit the community of garden-houses in Phu Mong and some traditional craft villages, just 5km far away from the center of Hue city - visit embroidery village of Kim Long to discover how they can embroider a whole picture. Next stop will be the bronze casting village, one of the most well-known bronze casting centers which produce different kinds of products, from a small vase to large burner. You also have a chance to see some the finest garden-houses in Hue.

PHONG NHA CAVE

Overview:

Phong Nha Caves are a complex of 14 grottoes situated in a region of Limestone Mountains in Ke Bang National Park. The caves were listed as a World Natural Heritage Site in July of 2003 by UNESCO. The only way to Phong Nha Cave is by boat. These seat up to fourteen people, and though it's theoretically possible to join other groups, you'll likely be told to charter one of your own. You'll drift awhile between rippling walls of limestone, and see immense stalactites and stalagmites, all lit by multi colored spotlights. This cave is really an amazing creation of nature.

Itinerary:

Morning, driver will escort you about 200km from Hue to the Son River in Quang Binh province, where you take a boat trip to the famed caves at Phong Nha – Ke Bang National Park. The Park is one of the world's two largest limestone regions. In comparison with 41 other world heritage sites which have karsts, Phong Nha has dissimilar geomorphic, geologic and biotic conditions. The karsts of Phong Nha can be traced back to Palaeozoic 400 million years ago. This makes Phong Nha is the oldest major karst in Asia. The area has numerous grottoes and caves. Vietnamese and British scientists have so far surveyed a total of 20 caves with a total length of 70 km. Of these surveyed caves, 17 were in the Phong Nha area and three in the Ke Bang area. Following the narrow underground river, you explore the most impressive Phong Nha cave, from which the name to the whole system. The Cave is famous for its rock formation which have been given names such as the "Lion", the "Fairy Caves", the "Royal Court", and the "Buddha". Afterwards, you return to Dong Hoi for lunch before driving back to Hue.
