



TOURS ESCAPE FROM QUY NHON

Quy Nhon is the coastal city in Binh Dinh province in central Vietnam. For local people, it is a kind of place to spend couples of day watching the ocean and walking promenade. For foreigners, it becomes less popular. But Quy Nhon deserves to be visited more even though it is not considered as a tourist destination. The medium-size city is blessed with a terrific shoreline of sandy beaches, appeal and tidy. And the countryside that surrounds it is also breathtaking.

Quy Nhon was established as the capital city in the late 19th century but its history dates back to the 11th century in the time of Champa Kingdom. In the 15th century, it also served as the ruling center of Le Thanh Tong – one of the greatest emperors of Vietnamese history. During the Vietnam War, it was a site for intense battle and an important US military and naval base.

Today, the city is a developing port. Fishing and agriculture are the main industries here, making it a food spot to sample some fresh seafood. This destination is highly recommended for seafood lovers.

Overview:

A relaxing program combines a beautiful nature reserve with a visit to the Quang Trung museum. Travel by boat along the river, immerse in the magical world of nature, be awed by the creation of the nature with natural marble in various sizes scattered along the riverbed, you will feel like going into a mythical world.

Itinerary:

Afternoon, you are picked up at your hotel around then transfer to Ham Ho beautiful nature reserve 55km from Quy Nhon to taking up a jungle-lined 3km stretch of clean, fish-filled river, the park is best enjoyed by boat. Must say that it is the further up-river you travel, the better the swimming spots are.

Continue visit Quang Trung museum - is dedicated Nguyen Hue, a national hero of the 18th century. You will see displays include various statues, costumes, documents and artefacts from the 18th century, most of them labelled in English. Especially notable are the elephant-skin battle drums and gongs from the Bahnar tribe, also demonstrations of "Vo Binh Dinh" - a traditional martial art
